The [English Enhancement Programme](#) (EEP) is a suite of training options developed by the Education and Training Foundation to enable teachers in the FE and Skills sector to rise to the challenge of teaching GCSE English Language. Anyone within the sector is eligible for the programme provided they are currently employed by an SFA/EFA funded institution. Training places cost £100 per delegate.

In March and April, North Yorks ACL will be hosting one of the EEP programmes at North Allerton. It consists of two full day training days supported with blended learning and is made up of seven modules -

1. GCSE English qualifications, the current context
2. GCSE Overview of GCSE English
3. From Functional English to GCSE
4. Controlled Assessments 1
5. Controlled Assessment 2
6. GCSE Exams
7. Language Refresher
